Protect and Expand Access to Vital Health Care Services in Georgia

Since 1977, the Feminist Women's Health Center has been dedicated to providing accessible, respectful women's health care as well as community education and advocacy that advances reproductive health and justice. Our programs seek to give voice to the health issues of all women, including those who are underserved due to their race, ethnicity, socio-economic level, cultural orientation, sexuality, disability, size, age, or national origin.

A Proud Legacy

The Feminist Center has a proud history. We were part of a national movement that transformed health care to address women's needs. Our health care approach was based on "self-help." This is the idea that a woman, armed with knowledge of human sexuality, GYN care, and her body, will take charge of her health.

The Challenge Today

The unfortunate truth is that many women do not have genuine access to the full range of vital gynecological health care and information.

- Less than 90% of Georgia's counties have an abortion provider making access to care difficult for many women.
- Governmental restrictions also limit access to services and information, especially for young women, low-income women and for many women of color.
- Comprehensive sex education is not a reality in many public schools leaving many teens dangerously uninformed about prevention of pregnancy and STD's and HIV/AIDS.
- Unintended pregnancies and STD's still occur among adults who never received reliable information about how to properly use birth control or safer sex methods.
- Georgia's legislature has been on the brink of passing harmful bills limiting access to reproductive health care.
- Recent state budget cuts have curtailed funding of vital human and health services for the most vulnerable in our state.



- Health care disparities due to race, ethnicity, socio-economic status, sexual orientation, age, culture, disability, and other factors compound these accessibility and public policy issues.

The Feminist Center seeks to overcome barriers for underserved women and girls to obtain vital health care through community education and providing accessible, respectful services. Our approach takes it one step further by working to ensure that all women's voices are heard and counted in the policy debates affecting their lives, families, and realities. With our 3-pronged mission of empowering women through service, education and advocacy, we continue our proud legacy and rise to meet the challenges of today and the future.
